**How To Remove /opencms/opencms from URL**

Steps to remove /opencms/opencms from URL. This goal can easily be achieved by static export mechanism if this is required for a static site. But in case there are dynamic pages or we have to also remove /opencms/opencms from workplace URLs then following are the step -

First you need to change url pattern in web.xml

```
<url-pattern>/opencms/*</url-pattern>
```

change it to

```
<url-pattern>/*</url-pattern>
```

Then change following value in opencms.properties

```
url_prefix_http=${WEB_APP_NAME}/opencms
```

change it to blank value

```
url_prefix_http=
```

Then you will have to define following context in server.xml

```
<Context path="" docBase="opencms" debug="0"/>
```

After this step login URL will be <http://localhost:8080/system/login>

But after login images are not shown in workplace. This may be the problem if someone tried above options. To solve this problem there are two ways

1) Change following property to true in registry.xml

```
<UseWpPicturesFromVFS>>false</UseWpPicturesFromVFS>
```

OR

2) Define following context in server.xml

```
<Context path="/resources" docBase="opencms/resources" debug="0"/>
```

After this step images are shown properly in workplace and works fine.
